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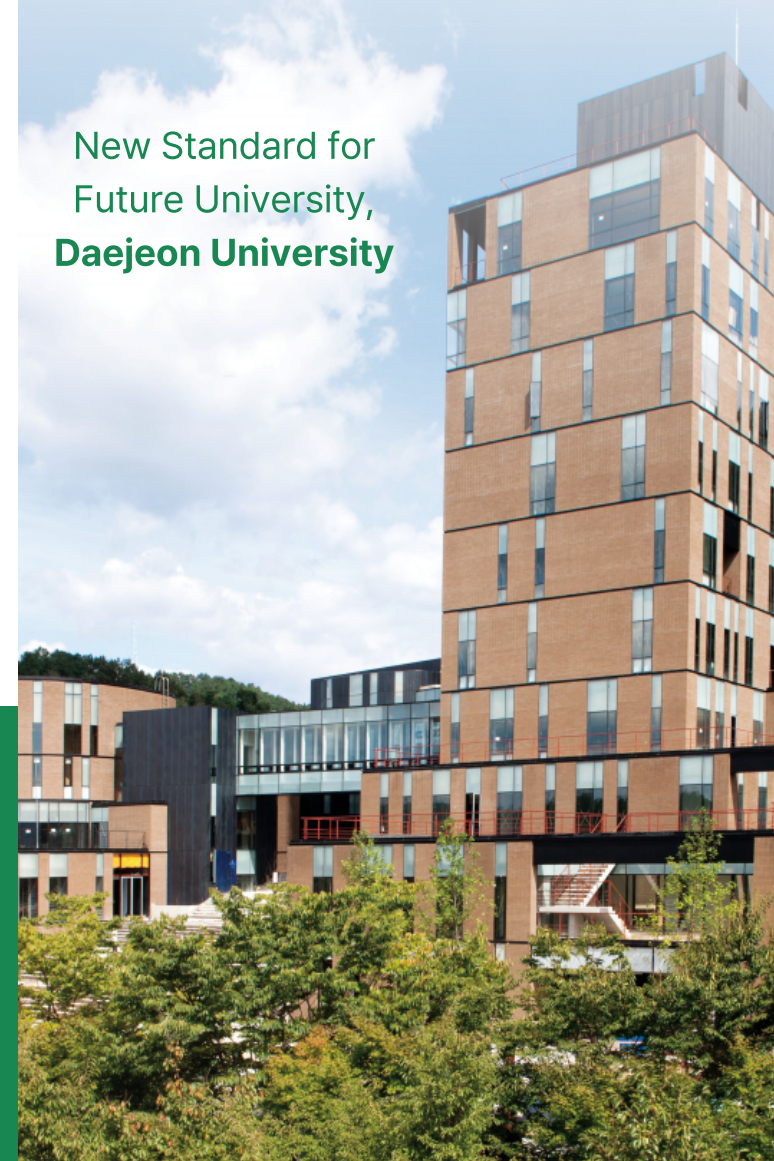

- Undergraduate students who have completed at least two semesters
- Minimum GPA of 2.8 / 4.0 or equivalent
- Academic Program: TOPIK 3 or above
- (Can be waived with an official reference letter from the home university)
- Language Program: No requirement

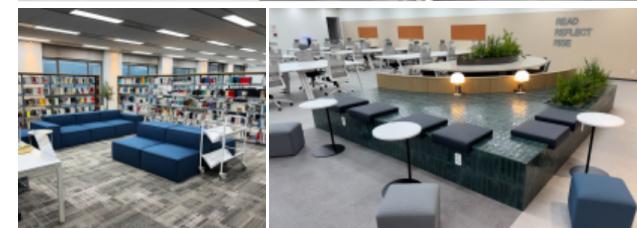

International students can use campus facilities such as the library, sports facilities, and shuttle bus for free just like other local students! Experience campus life just like a local student during your stay.

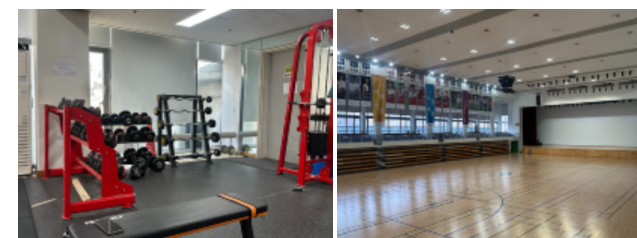
All facilities are easily accessible once the student ID card issued, to support both your academic and daily life.
